Old Business - Items discussed:

Spirit Shop:

We need someone to be the new Director. The trailer has some merchandise which is locked pending inventory and decision on sale etc....of those items. It was brought to our attention that the stadium Spirit Shop is to be open to all teams and their Booster Clubs. Hence, the reason that it was not adviseable to leave our shirts in the store when we are not actively selling from it. Roy wouldl like to see the shop look much more professional with new shelving and display units. He asked the membership to keep an eye out for store glass cabins and shelving from stores that may be closing or going out of business. Or we might solicit a cabinetmaker to provide us with a quote for building needed shelving. Something we should look into with pricing.
